HISTORY OF ARCHITECTURE ([Webpage](#)) ([Gallery](#))

In Europe from the late c14 there had been a Renaissance in art and architecture and we will look at that movement as it was so important to architecture. Due to England being so self centred under the two Henry's and then Elizabeth, England seemed to largely miss out on the architectural Renaissance although we were influenced in music, visual arts and literature. Renaissance is not recognized in the list of architectural periods in England. Following the Renaissance, Europe moves on to Baroque at about the period that the slight influence of Renaissance appears here so we will look at the flamboyant Baroque in Europe. Following the Tudor period we get Stuart or Jacobean as it is known, so we will begin to explore that period and there are many fine examples to look at.
