Current members who have indicated they do not have internet access will receive a form through the post.

Payment is by cash or cheque payable to **Cheadle (Staffs) u3a**.

Members renewing at the coffee morning will be issued with a new card 2022 in person

Members wishing to renew by post need to return their form and payment and must enclose a **Self-Addressed Envelope** to the Membership Secretary (see the membership form).

A small charge of £2 per session per member is payable for each activity attended.

Where activities are organised via zoom meetings individual groups currently have their own arrangements for payment for sessions.

Gift Aid

The u3a is a registered charity, we are able to make a claim for Gift Aid from HMRC for any member who is a UK taxpayer, which equates to 25% of their membership payment.

This is a boost to our income and makes a real difference to our finances.

By agreeing to gift aid on our membership forms you enable us to make a claim.

Please notify the u3a charity (Alan our membership secretary) if you:

- **want to cancel this declaration**
- **change your name or home address**
- **no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains**

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

Please understand, if you pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all donations you make in a tax year it is your responsibility to pay any difference.
